

OARC Neutrality Policy

- OARC will not offer commercial for-profit DNS services.
- OARC will not enter into exclusive arrangements or discriminate in its dealings with Members or Registries.
- OARC will make all its data, tools and services available to the Public, or to all Members, on an equitable basis.
- OARC will not operate DNS production infrastructure on behalf of individual Members.
- OARC will not enter arrangements to share revenue with individual Members.
- All contracts and arrangements with Members that are not covered by the Participation Agreement will be transparent to the Membership, and subject to Board oversight.
- DNS-OARC shall be able to engage in software/service development and research/analysis projects, either alone or in partnership, in order to fund its continuing operations or further its mission. Such projects shall be approved by the Board on a case-by-case basis.
- Approval of projects and arrangements above will be noted in Board minutes, reported to the Membership at least annually, and relevant contracts made available to Members upon request.
